



SYSA Parent Agreement

Parents of soccer players agree to follow BC Soccer parents code of conduct:

1. Encourage your child and other participants in BC soccer to abide by the rules and, in general, emphasize sportsmanship.
2. Explain players' code of conduct to your child and encourage to follow it.
3. Encourage your son/daughter to play fairly and to the best of his/her ability and, when he/she does so, to provide praise and encouragement regardless of the results of those efforts.
4. Encourage your son/daughter to respect teammates, coaches, team manager, referees, and opponents. 5. Encourage your son/daughter to refrain from dangerous play during games and practices.
6. Cheering for your child is great, but please refrain from coaching from the sidelines or near the goal.
7. Refrain from criticism of coaches, referees, or opponents during games and in the presence of your child or other children. Constructive criticism, when you feel necessary, should be directed towards your teams' coaches in private.
8. When able, assist with tasks as requested by coaches or managers (e.g., putting nets away after games, providing half-time snacks, etc).
9. Ensure attendance of your child at games and practices and if absences are unavoidable, to give adequate notice to coaches or manager.
10. Ensure that your child is prepared (water, clothing and being focused) for practices and games.
11. 24hr cooling off period for parents after games and practices– then contact the coach to arrange for a meeting with or without your child.
